Legal Profession (Society) Rules 2007
[rule 11]**Application for Membership of the Queensland Law Society**

'Full' membership of the Society is available for those practitioners who hold a current practising certificate but who do not engage in practice as or in the manner of a barrister or to Australian registered foreign lawyers. If you do not fit into either of those categories, you may be entitled to apply for 'associate' membership of the Society. If you do not hold a current practising certificate and wish to be a 'full' member, you may make application to the Secretary.
