

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Queensland Law Society Incorporated (the Society) will collect personal information when a response is submitted.
2. Responses must include the respondent's name and address for mailing purposes.
3. The information will only be used for the purpose of mailing tickets to successful respondents.
4. Personal information provided by respondents may be transferred and stored overseas to administer the Society's services and communications to members. By responding you agree to this transfer.

6. The Society is provided with free movie passes and offers these passes to members by requesting members to answer a question by email.
7. Dependent upon the number of free passes the Society has for each draw, the correct answers received first will receive the free pass.
8. Respondents may only submit one response.
9. Submission of a response will be taken to be acceptance of the terms and conditions.
10. Successful respondents will receive their free passes by prepaid mail. Failure to provide a postal address for delivery will lead to forfeiture of the pass.
11. The passes are not redeemable for cash.
12. The Society's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. The Society does not warrant or guarantee the validity of the passes or the availability of the movie promoted by the passes.
14. The Society shall not be liable for any cost, loss or expense arising out of the acceptance of the passes or participation in the promotion including any damage or injury suffered or sustained including personal injury, loss of opportunity or profit or damage to property whether direct or indirect or consequential or due to the deliberate or negligent acts of omissions of the Society or otherwise.
15. The Society does not warrant or represent the quality, suitability or appropriateness of the movies promoted and does not endorse the movies or the promoter(s) of the movies.

The Society may cancel, suspend or modify the offer for any reason including computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any other cause beyond the Society's control which may affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the offer.

The Society may also cancel, suspend or modify the offer if the determination of the successful respondent(s) or the delivery of the passes is prevented or hindered by any outside agent or event including but not limited to vandalism, power failure, tempest, natural disaster, acts of God, civil unrest or strikes or other industrial action.
