Conditions of entry

Entrants must have:

- attended the QLS Criminal Law Conference, hosted by the Promoter on Friday 2 August 2019, held at the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre; and
- completed the feedback form and submitted it to either a Queensland Law Society staff member or placed it in the draw box at the Queensland Law Society registration desk.

There is no entry fee to enter this draw.

By submitting your feedback form you will be entering this competition and will be considered to be in acceptance of these terms and conditions.

Entry period

Entry into the prize draw opens at 8.00am AEST on Friday 2 August 2019 and closes at 5.35pm AEST on Friday 2 August 2019.

Entry method

Entrants must complete the feedback form and submit it to either a Queensland Law Society staff member or place it in the draw box at the Queensland Law Society registration desk.

Maximum number of entries

An entrant may enter the prize draw only once during the entry period – for a maximum of one (1) entry in total.

Draw details

One (1) random draw will be conducted as follows:

Prize details

Publication details

Prize claim and date
