Community feedback and recommendations to amend the Transport and Other Legislation (Managing E-mobility Use and Protecting Our Communities) Amendment Bill 2026

The Queensland Law Society (QLS) welcomes the report of the State Development, Infrastructure and Works Committee recommending significant changes to the Transport and Other Legislation (Managing E-mobility Use and Protecting Our Communities) Amendment Bill 2026.

The Committee's engagement with the community feedback on the Bill was a very positive outcome of the legislative consultation process.

The changes recommended by the Committee will benefit many community groups. QLS was particularly pleased to see the Committee's careful consideration of feedback from the disability community. The Committee's recommendations recognise the sensible changes needed to address the impacts of the Bill in its current form.

The parliamentary committee process demonstrated the substantial community interest in these reforms. Given the wide-ranging scope of the Committee's recommendations, it would be ideal if further public consultation was undertaken of proposed amendments before an updated Bill is introduced to Parliament. In our submission to the inquiry, we recommended specific consultation with people with disability, disability advocates and other lived experience stakeholders. We again reiterate this recommendation for continued consultation on the Bill given the complexities associated with the reform.

QLS would be pleased to work with the Department in reviewing the draft amendments, to assist with identifying any unintended consequences of amended drafting before parliament considers updated legislation.

QLS policy committee members bring valuable expertise and lived experience in considering the practical outcomes of draft legislation.
