Option 1: Online Survey

The online survey is open to all staff employed by legal service providers and court stakeholders, including court staff and other specialist service providers. The survey is anonymous and should take around 15 minutes to complete. Questions are a mix of multiple choice and free text. If you do not want to take the survey after you start, you can stop and exit the survey.
