Treasury Laws Amendment (Measures for Consultation) Bill 2021: Use of technology for meetings and related amendments

Thank you for the opportunity to provide comments on the Federal Government's exposure draft legislation, the Treasury Laws Amendment (Measures for Consultation) Bill 2021: Use of technology for meetings and related amendments. This legislation contains permanent reforms to facilitate the use of technology in meetings, to execute documents and send meeting-related materials.

The Queensland Law Society supports the revised draft of this legislation. In our view, the provisions that relate to the execution of documents have been significantly simplified from prior versions and, as the explanatory memorandum indicates, make it easier to extend this approach across other parts of the *Corporations Act 2001*.
